

APPLICATION PROCESS

NOTICE OF INTENT

This informs MT DES that a jurisdiction wants to apply for a grant.

APPLICATION COMPLETION

MT DES will assist with completing an application for a FEMA grant.

RANKING

MT DES will score and rank applications based on which grant a jurisdiction is applying for.

APPLICATION PROCESS

FEMA SUBMISSION

FEMA REVIEW

AWARD

PROJECT IMPLENTATION

MT DES will submit applications to FEMA, by deadline.

FEMA will review applications to determine eligibility, feasibility, and cost effectiveness.

If approved, MT DES will formally award the grant to the jurisdiction.

The jurisdiction can now begin their grant.
